It is hard to believe that we are already into our eighth week of school and holidays are not too far away now. For the past weeks all students have been enjoying the school life and have happily engaged with their peers and teachers, with lots of exciting learning happening.

Grade One students have now completed their unit of work on 'My Australia' and are currently starting their new Science topic on Seasons where they will discuss, make prediction and investigate observable changes in the sky and landscape.

As for the Grade Twos, they are now starting their end of term ThinkPlus project on presentation of neurons and how they connect. Working as small groups, the students are investigating the structure of a neuron and how it fires and wires within the brain. They are also thinking of a variety of ways to build their neurons using collage, playdough, paper sculpture or mixed media.
