Rosewood Downs Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our voluntary financial contributions for 2024. Please find the fee schedule for Grade 3 & 4 2024 attached.

Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all your support. This has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer. This year we received north of 80% contributions and this money was integral to allowing our students to receive equitable learning opportunities.

Within our school this support has allowed us to start to re-equip our classrooms with new resources, as we develop into a science of learning school, we will be required to purchase decodable readers as part of our synthetic phonics program. This money also goes towards expanding opportunities for our students. At RDPS we are mindful of the impact that inflation and rising interest rates have had on all of us. Rather than increasing our parent payments in line with inflation we have done everything we can to ensure that our parent payments are the exact same as 2023.

As in previous years, we have arranged the day prior to the start of school for parents to make their fee and student book pack payments. This will take place on Monday 29th January between 8:45am – 4:00pm.

FREE INSTRUCTION
